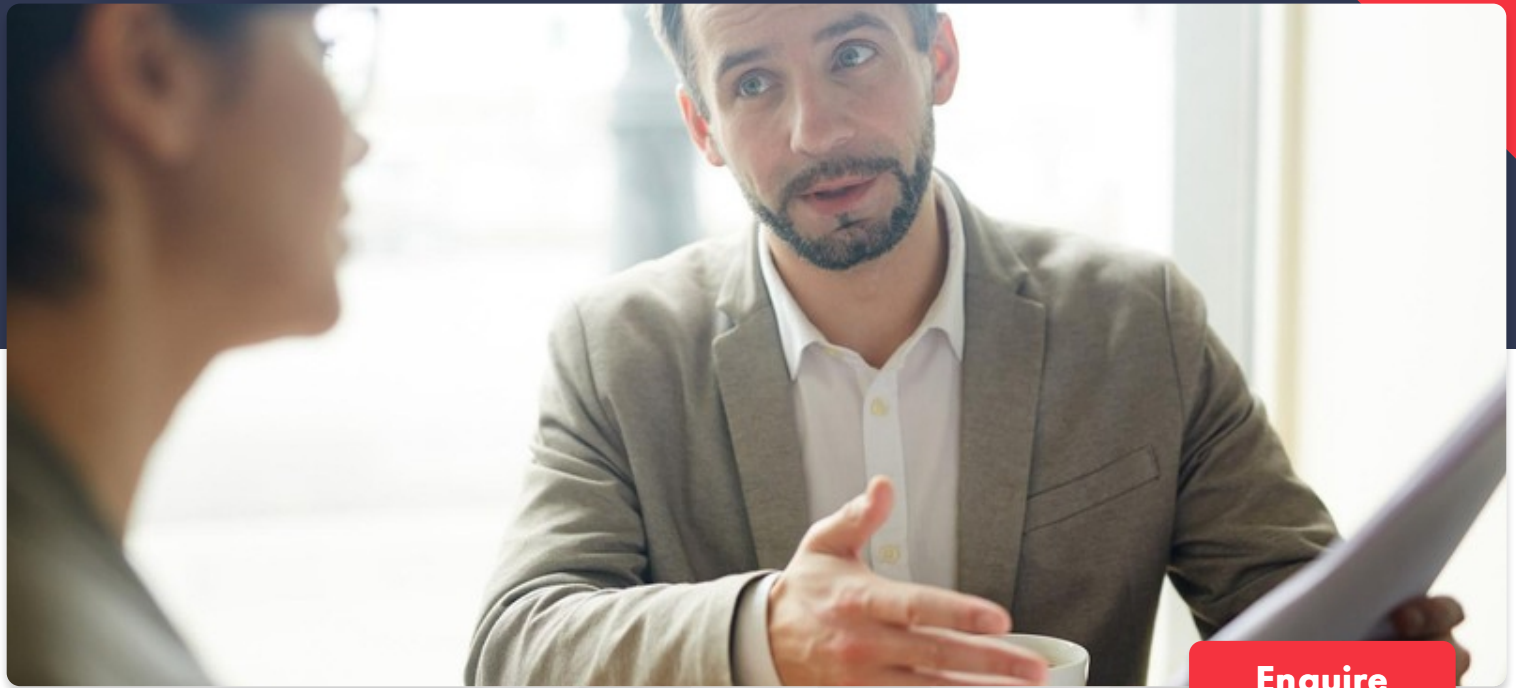



Overview

The aim of this Skills Bootcamp is to provide an understanding of the core elements of project controls. It offers the opportunity to complete the ECITB Planning & Scheduling Practice and the ECITB Introduction to Estimating courses, as well as gain an understanding of commercial awareness.

Blended Learning

The project controls bootcamp is a fusion of academic and practical delivery methods. The course begins with a kick-off session to provide course information and objectives. A competency assessment will take place following the induction and will be repeated at the end of the Bootcamp.

DfE Skills Bootcamp - Learner Eligibility

To be funded, learners must meet all the following criteria:

- must be aged 19 or older, or will reach their 19th birthday on or before 31 August 2022 and
- have the right to work in the UK. This can be checked on [gov.uk/view-right-to-work](https://www.gov.uk/view-right-to-work) and
- meet residency requirements & have lived in the UK for at least 3 years.

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Learning Outcomes

The Skills Bootcamp will cover the following ECITB courses:

ECITB Planning & Scheduling Practice

- Understand the importance of planning and scheduling - describe the importance of good planning and the main terms used in planning and scheduling.
- Understand the processes required to produce schedules
- Prepare schedules for the control of work scope delivery
- Produce planning information (including schedules) in the right format to meet stakeholder needs and to gain buy-in
- Understand other processes relating to scheduling

As part of the ECITB Planning & Scheduling Practice course, candidates are required to complete a two part end of course assessment. This includes a multiple choice test and a practical assessment.

ECITB Introduction to Estimating

- Understand the concepts of estimating within a project environment
- Understanding the fundamentals of project scope and requirements
- Understand different estimating techniques
- Understand estimating requirements within different life cycles
- Understand why re-estimating takes place
- Understand the implications and reasons for poor estimating
- Understand the component parts of an estimate
- Consider contingency within estimating
- Consider information which forms the basis of estimates

ECITB Commercial Awareness

- Understand the key aspects of commercial awareness
- Understand the importance of risk management and the main terms used

Certification

At the end of the Skills Bootcamp, delegates will receive an official certification for the programme. A certificate will also be received on successful completion of the application workshops.
